

St Margaret's Church of England Primary - Curriculum Overview - Autumn Term 2nd half

<p>English will be taught daily alongside daily phonics sessions; fortnightly 1:1 reading and daily whole-class guided reading. This term will be exploring a range of texts, including Dear Mother Goose and Traction Man. We will be writing letters, using adjectives and conjunctions, speech, past and progressive sentences.</p>	<p>We will be continuing with our focus on place value within 20 as well as Shape. We will be focusing on teen numbers, addition and subtraction, practising numbers within 20 as well as exploring common 2d and 3d shapes.</p>	<p>Science - Animals including Humans This term we will be looking at Humans. We will be identifying, naming and drawing the basic parts of the human body, observing facial features, exploring their 5 senses, in particular, exploring smell and hearing.</p>	<p>This term we will be focusing on Special books from other faiths and The Christmas Story. We will look at books such as The Torah and Guru Granth. We will be looking at the importance of Angel Gabriel and the nativity story. In November, we will also be reflecting on those who were involved and died in conflicts of war, through Remembrance Day.</p>

<p>Geography - Where do, and did the wheels on the bus go? We will be exploring Oldham, finding Oldham on a map of the UK, naming the 4 countries that make up the UK, as well as their capital cities. We will look at how we can explore and travel around the UK and make a model that is able to move.</p>	<p>This term in Art we will be exploring how to draw and explore Autumn leaves. We will be exploring whether they are wax resistant and making Autumn floor drawings. In Design and Technology we will explore a range of materials and construction techniques in the unit of work wheels and axis.
