Uniform

Pupils will wear:

- ✚ a blue shirt and school tie
- ✚ a navy v-necked jumper or navy sweatshirt
- ✚ girls may wear a v-necked jumper or a v-necked cardigan
- ✚ Skirts and trousers will be light/mid grey only
- ✚ All children will wear black shoes and if wearing skirts girls will wear grey socks or grey tights.

Summer Uniform (optional)

The girls can wear a light blue gingham dress (not navy), with white socks and navy cardigan. Boys can wear light/ to mid grey shorts. Uniform can be purchased from Debonair (indoor market) with the school emblem on, but cheaper alternatives (without the emblem) can be obtained from most high street super markets.

School ties and book bags are available to purchase from the school office at a cost of £3.00 each.

Nursery and Reception

For indoor P.E. lessons a plain light blue t-shirt and dark blue shorts will be needed.

KS1 and KS2

For indoor P.E. lessons a plain light blue t-shirt and dark blue shorts will be needed.

For outdoor P.E. and games sessions the children need a pair of trainers, joggers and sweatshirt.

P.E Kit is best kept in school in a small drawstring bag, so that it is always available. The children should take their P.E. kit home periodically to get it washed.

Jewellery

In the interests of safety and security the children may only wear stud earrings and a watch to school. No other jewellery is acceptable. All children will be asked to remove items of jewellery for P.E. and sports sessions.

We request that ear piercing takes place during the summer holidays to allow healing and prevent children missing P.E., sports and swimming sessions.

Hair, Make-up and Nails

No makeup, nail varnish or false nails should be worn during the school day. Temporary transfers or fake 'tattoos' are not acceptable.

During term time pupils are not allowed extreme or fashion hairstyles, which includes dyed or streaked hair, shaving, patterns and tramlines, mohicans and mowhawks. Hair gel is not allowed.

Hairbands and Bobbles

Any hair bobbles worn at school should be plain and in royal blue, navy or black. Headbands should be thin and plain in royal blue, navy or black. Fancy bands with adornments e.g large flowers should not be worn for school.
